

Privacy Policy for Sports Associations

Move Copenhagens data responsibility

We process personal information and have therefore adopted this Privacy Policy, which briefly tells you how we treat your personal information to ensure fair and transparent data processing.

Throughout our data processing, we only process personal data for specific purposes and based on legitimate interests. We only process personal information that is relevant and necessary to fulfill the stated purposes and we delete your information when it is no longer necessary.

Move Copenhagen is the data controller, and we ensure that your personal data is processed in accordance with the legislation.

Processing of personal data

We process the following personal information:

1. Information about the festival participant
 - a. General personal information: Registration and contact information that is given when registering for the festival. The following information is collected as is the name, e-mail address.
 - b. Personal information that has a higher level of protection: none
2. Information about trainers
 - a. General personal information: Registration and contact information provided when setting up in the teacher database, which is the name, address, telephone number, and e-mail address, as well as information about workshops.
 - b. Personal information that has a higher level of protection: none
3. Information about volunteers, community builders, cool down team
 - a. General personal data: Registration and contact information that is submitted when registering as a volunteer. The following information is collected as is the name, e-mail address, as well as information on the wish for a task/groups.
 - b. Personal information that has a higher level of protection: none

4. Information about Move core volunteers
 - a. General personal information: Contact information collected on request for general information. Contact List. The following information is collected as is the name, telephone number, birthday, address, email address
 - b. Personal information that has a higher level of protection: Account Number and CPR of Presidents.

Here we collect information from

We always get the information directly from you and do not collect information from others.

The purpose of the association with the processing of your personal data

Legal grounds for treatment are:

- The association's legitimate interests in processing your information (balance of interests)
- That it is necessary to fulfill a contract with you
- Treatment according to legal requirements
- Treatment with consent

The objectives:

1. Purpose of processing participant information, community builders, incl. cool down team:
 - a. The association's participant handling, including ticket collection
 - b. As part of the association's activities, including planning, implementation, and follow-up
 - c. Compliance with legal requirements, including the Public Education Act
 - d. Delivery of goods and services you have ordered (the ticket)
 - e. Managing your relationship with us
2. Purpose of processing information on the teacher, Move core volunteers - in addition to the above:
 - a. Handling of tasks and duties in the association
 - b. Overview of an improvement of the experience

We only process personal data based on legitimate interests

To the extent that we treat your membership information on the basis of the interest-balancing rule, this treatment will be solely motivated by legitimate interests such as:

- Handling of your rights according to the articles of association etc., including in relation to the general meeting
- Fulfillment of participant duties, including collection and payment of festival tickets, etc.
- Organizing social events, sporting activities, and other activities.
- Use of situational images taken in the association, which depicts a concrete activity or situation in the association - separate consent retrieved during sign up process.

- Transmission of your ordinary personal data to special federations in DIF, to DGI and to DGI's regional offices, in relevant and necessary scope in connection with sports activities (only Core volunteers)
- For the sake of contact possibilities, information about the parents can be processed for children and adolescents under the age of 18
- Preservation of information with historical value for statistics and the like

Consent

Most often, our processing of your personal data will be based on a legal basis other than consent. We therefore only collect your consent when in rare cases it is necessary.

If we obtain your consent, it is voluntary to consent and you may withdraw it at any time by notifying us.

Transmission of your personal information

In connection with sports activities, information is transmitted to relevant sports organizations.

We do not pass on personal information to companies for marketing without your consent.

Storing and deleting your personal data

We have different treatment purposes and storage periods depending on whether we treat your personal data as a member of the association, as an unpaid manager or trainer or as a paid manager or trainer:

Participants, trainers, volunteers, community builders:

We will keep your personal information for a period from the termination of membership and in accordance with the following criteria:

- For practical and administrative reasons, we keep your regular membership information for up to [3 years] after the calendar year for your registration of the association.
- However, we keep anonymous information on participants for statistics and the like, as long as they have historical value.

Move core volunteers:

We will keep your personal information for a period from the termination of your activity and in accordance with the following criteria:

- Posting documents, including for example wage documents must be stored for 5 years from the end of the financial year to which the annex relates
- Other relevant information for follow-up and assessment of any requirements are saved for [5 years] after the work has ended

Your rights

You have a number of special rights under the Personal Data Regulation when we process personal information about you:

- The right to be informed about the processing of data
- The right to access your own personal data
- The right to rectification

- The right to delete
- The right to limit treatment
- The right to data portability (disclosure of data in a commonly used format)
- The right to object

You can use your rights, including objecting to our treatment, by contacting us. You will find our contact information at the top.

For example, if you contact a request to correct or delete your personal information, we will investigate whether the conditions are met and then make changes or deletions as soon as possible.

You can always file a complaint with a Data Protection Supervisor, eg. Data Protection Agency.

Revision of privacy policy

We reserve the right to make changes to this Privacy Policy from time to time. Changes will change the date at the top of the privacy policy. The privacy policy in force at any time will be available on our site. In the event of significant changes, you will receive notice of this.
